To continue this trend, the Operations Associate is required to support the professional golf operation, pick and clean the range, maintain cleanliness of the facility, run the register, answer the phone, provide excellent customer service and complete other duties as needed. Our goal is to provide country club-like professionalism with a community centric environment accepting of all people regardless of age, gender, race, experience, or background.

The Operations Associate is expected to work flexible hours, weekends, and some holidays.

Time Commitment: Approximately 25-35 hours per week

Responsibilities:

- Maintain the professionalism and culture of the facility
- Operate equipment to pick the range, clean the golf balls
- Ability to run the front register, handle cash, and answer questions appropriately
- Provide a high level of professionalism and customer service
- Day to day operations, supporting inventory sales, and facility appearance
- Ensure proper use of the facility by patrons
- Support strategic plan efforts as directed by the Director of Golf Operations
- Ability to solve problems, multi-task
- Other duties as assigned by Director of Golf Operations

- Driver's License Required

- Golf knowledge preferred but not required
